A BB and Chinese automotive parts supplier, Hasco, have unveiled a joint venture.

The JV will build on the existing relationship between the two companies, leading to the development of sustainable auto parts manufacturing in Hasco's China-based operations.

The partnership, which includes a 40% stake by ABB in the joint venture, will expand the use of smart technologies and artificial intelligence. Both parties agreed not to disclose any further details concerning the investment.


ABB says it was the first multinational robot supplier in China to localise its full value chain, from R&D, manufacturing, sales, engineering and system integration.
